Racing Australia's **myhorseracing.horse** Portal Expands For Trainers

Racing Australia continues to invest in improving and expanding its tools to make it easier for industry participants to lodge and complete essential industry functions.

Launched in 2019 **myhorseracing.horse** enables Owners and Managing Owners to lodge and manage Owner-related functions online without the need for paper forms.

The existing online tool for Trainers known as Stable Assist has served the industry well for many years. Over 80% of Trainers nationally utilise Stable Assist to lodge Nominations, Acceptances, Withdrawals, Scratchings, Stable Returns and Retirement Notifications.

Consistent with Racing Australia's strategy to establish **myhorseracing.horse** as the one central location for all Racing Australia industry functions, a redevelopment of Stable Assist commenced earlier this year.

Utilising feedback from Trainers on how online tools for Trainers could be improved, Racing Australia established a small pilot group of Trainers to trial new developments. The feedback and suggestions provided by this pilot group assisted Racing Australia in its quest to provide the best possible online tools service for Trainers.

After a period of consultation, testing and further enhancements all of the Trainer functions available to Trainers in Stable Assist are now available on the one industry portal **myhorseracing.horse**.

"The addition of Trainer tools to **myhorseracing.horse** is the next step in Racing Australia's strategy to move all Owner, Trainer and Breeder functions onto the new industry portal using the one RA ID across Owner, Trainer and Breeder functions" said Myles Foreman, CEO of Racing Australia.

To manage the transition of Trainers from the current Stable Assist to **myhorseracing.horse** Racing Australia is staggering its introduction. Racing Australia has now commenced progressively contacting trainers with an invitation to activate an RA ID enabling access to the new **myhorseracing.horse**. This process is expected to be completed by the end of 2020. Where the Trainer already has an RA ID as an Owner, they will also be progressively contacted to activate the new Trainer functions replacing Stable Assist.

The current Stable Assist will remain in operation during this transition.
